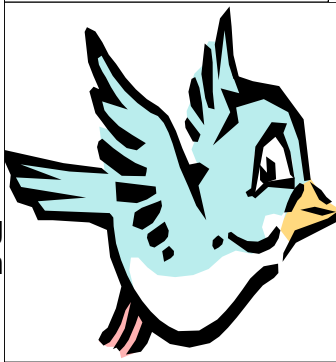
Please remember to label anything that you bring in for your baby with both first and last names. Check your items often because labels tend to fall off!

With the change in the season, we would like you all to check your child's extra clothing. Make sure you have enough of each item and that they are seasonally appropriate.

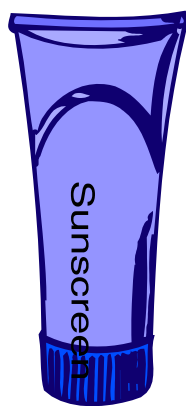
We would also like to thank all of the parents for their kindness and generosity during teacher appreciation week.

Welcome to Summer camp! Please remember to bring a nut free lunch that does not need to be heated. Remember that you need to send in a bathing suit and towel everyday for swim.

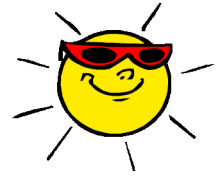
We are going to be very busy this summer..... singing, dancing, and having lots of fun outdoors.

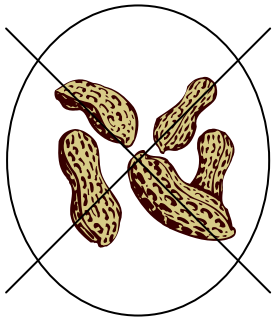
